This Nenkin Teiki Bin (Pension Coverage Regular Notice: PCRN) is sent to you so that you can confirm your pension coverage records on our database (full history), learn about your estimated benefit amounts and understand more about pension system.

In the fiscal year 2009, we are sending the Notices to all the insured persons to inform individual pension coverage records (full history) under the public pension systems except for those under the Mutual Aid Associations.

On and after the fiscal year 2010, we will send the Notice individually to inform pension coverage records as follows:

- ▶ For the fiscal year you become 35, 45 or 58 years old, you will receive your pension coverage records (full history) under the public pension systems (except for those under the Mutual Aid Associations).
- ▶ For other fiscal years, you will receive your pension coverage records of exclusively past one year.
